AN ACT to amend the Physiotherapists' Registration Act 1951 for the purpose of enabling registered chiropractors to carry out physiotherapeutic treatment without having to be registered under that Act.

[Royal Assent 28 October 1982]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Physiotherapists' Registration Amendment Act 1982*. Short title.

Commence-

2—This Act shall commence on the same day as that fixed under section 2 (3) of the *Chiropractors Registration Act* 1982.

3—Section 24 (2) of the *Physiotherapists' Registration Act* 1951* is amended as follows:—

(a) by omitting from paragraph (b) “ persons; or ” and substituting “ persons; ”;

(b) by omitting from paragraph (c) “ Act.” and substituting “ Act; or ”;

(c) by inserting the following paragraph after paragraph (c):—

(d) being a person registered as a chiropractor under the *Chiropractors Registration Act* 1982, applies any physiotherapeutic treatment in the course of practising chiropractic within the meaning of that Act.

Expiry.

4—This Act shall expire at the expiration of the period of 2 years beginning on the commencement of section 2, and after that date the *Physiotherapists' Registration Act* 1951 shall have effect as if this Act had never been enacted.
