

## PARLIAMENTARY RETIRING ALLOWANCES.

### No. 11 of 1972.

AN ACT to amend the *Parliamentary Retiring Allowances Act 1955*. [13 July 1972.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Parliamentary Retiring Allowances Act 1972*. Short title, citation, and commencement.

(2) The *Parliamentary Retiring Allowances Act 1955*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the day on which the Principal Act commenced.

**2** Section thirteen of the Principal Act is amended by inserting in subsection (4) thereof, after the word “person” (first occurring), the words “(not being a member to whom paragraph (a) of subsection (5) of section sixteen relates)”. Benefits for members.

## SOFT FRUIT INDUSTRY.

### No. 12 of 1972.

AN ACT to make provision with respect to the regulation of the soft fruit industry, to amend the *Fruit and Vegetables Act 1953*, and to repeal the *Stone and Berry Fruits Board Act 1939*. [17 July 1972.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—
