PARLIAMENTARY RETIRING ALLOWANCES.

No. 11 of 1972.

AN ACT to amend the *Parliamentary Retiring Allowances Act* 1955. [13 July 1972.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Parliamentary Retiring Short title, citation, and commencement.
- (2) The Parliamentary Retiring Allowances Act 1955, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the day on which the Principal Act commenced.
- **2** Section thirteen of the Principal Act is amended by inserting Benefits for in subsection (4) thereof, after the word "person" (first occurring), the words "(not being a member to whom paragraph (a) of subsection (5) of section sixteen relates)".
