AN ACT to amend the Police Regulation Act 1898.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

[Royal Assent 1 May 1985]

1—This Act may be cited as the *Police Regulation Amendment Act 1985*. Short title.

2—This Act shall commence on the day fixed under section 2 (2) of the *Tasmanian State Service Act 1984*. Commencement.

Principal Act.

3—In this Act, the *Police Regulation Act 1898** is referred to as the Principal Act.

4—Section 49B of the Principal Act is amended by omitting paragraph (a) and substituting the following paragraph:—

(a) one shall be the Commissioner for Review or his nominee;
