AN ACT to amend the Pensioners' Rate Remissions Assistance Act 1974.

[30 November 1976]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Pensioners' Rate Remissions Assistance Act 1976*. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Pensioners' Rate Remissions Assistance Act 1974*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Interpretation.

2 Section 2 of the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof (in alignment with the first line of the section) the words “and includes a Member of the Forces or Returned Soldier as defined for the purposes of Part III of the *Repatriation Act* 1920 of the Commonwealth who is permanently unemployable within the meaning of that expression under that Part and is in receipt of a pension under that Act but is not eligible to receive a service pension thereunder”.
