AN ACT to amend the *Public Service Act 1923*. A.D. 1940.
[27 June, 1940.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Public Service Act 1940*. Short title.

2 The Principal Act is hereby amended—

- I. By inserting at the end of subsection (3) of section twenty-two thereof the words “at such rate not exceeding the rate which was payable to the officer, whose place he was assigned to fill, at the time when he took over such duties, as the Commissioner in each case may determine.”: and

II. By adding at the end of subsection (3) of section fifty-four thereof the words "and who was an officer at that date."

3 Where an officer is absent from duty for the purposes of service in defence of his country in the naval, military, or air forces of the Commonwealth in connection with the present war, his place may be filled by the appointment of another officer in an acting capacity at such salary as the Commissioner may determine, and the provisions of subsection (3) of section twenty-two of the Principal Act shall not apply to such appointment.
