AN ACT to amend the *Public Service Act 1923*. A.D. 1941.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- (a) By deleting the word “forty-one” in subsection 2 and substituting therefor the word “fifty-six”:

 - (ii) “nine” to “twelve months” in subsection (6) and substituting “two years”:

- (d) By deleting “two” in the last line of subsection (8) and substituting “three”:

III. By deleting the words “provided” (first occurring in subsection (1) of section sixty-eight thereof) to “Act” (in the next line thereof).

Extension of
certain
appointments
during
continuance
of war.

3 During the continuance of the war which commenced on the third day of September, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-nine, if the Commissioner is satisfied that the circumstances warrant the continuance of any temporary appointment beyond the relevant period prescribed by section thirty-one of the Principal Act, he may continue such appointment beyond such period, but not later than the termination of the said war.
