BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative
Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled,
as follows:—

I. By inserting at the end of subsection (4) of section twenty-four thereof the words “or by regulations under this Act prescribing cost of living adjustments upon prescribed bases”:

Section 68A.

II. By inserting after “officer” in the second line of section sixty-eight A thereof the words “made to the Commissioner”: and

Section 76.

III. By inserting after paragraph IX. of subsection (1) of section seventy-six thereof the following new paragraph X.—

“X. The allowances to be made to officers and other employees by way of adjustment on account of fluctuation in the cost of living as determined on prescribed bases, and the deductions to be made from salary where the cost of living falls below a prescribed figure.”
