AN ACT to amend the *Penguin Sewerage Act* 1913. [16 November, 1950.]

B^E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:--

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Penguin Sewerage Short title and citation. Act 1950.

(2) The *Penguin Sewerage Act* 1913*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section two of the Principal Act is amended by inserting Interpreafter the word "above" at the end of the definition of "The ^{tation.} sewerage district" the words "and such other areas within the Municipality of Penguin as the Council from time to time by special resolution may declare to be within the sewerage district.".

4—(1) Upon passing a special resolution for that purpose in pursuance of the provisions of the *Local Government Act* **1906*** it shall be lawful for the Council on behalf of the Corporation in addition to any other moneys already borrowed under the Principal Act to borrow any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole the further sum of twenty-five thousand pounds for the purpose of defraying the cost and expense of or connected with the completion, carrying out, or extension of all or any of the purposes of the Principal Act.

(2) Notwithstanding anything in the Principal Act contained it shall not be necessary to take any poll as provided by the Principal Act in respect of any moneys borrowed under this Act.
