AN ACT to amend the Public Service Act 1973.

[24 October 1974]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Public Service Act* 1974. Short title and citation.
- (2) The *Public Service Act* 1973 is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Absence from duty in relation to childbirth.

- **2** Section 88 of the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the following subsection:—
- "(10) This section applies to a woman temporarily employed in the Public Service as it applies to a female officer; and, in such a case, so applies whether she became pregnant before or after becoming so employed.".
