### ANALYSIS

1. Short title and citation.
2. Pension payable in case of member who died before appointed day.



**AN ACT to amend the Parliamentary Superannuation Act 1973.**

**[21 November 1974]**

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Parliamentary Superannuation Act 1974*. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Parliamentary Superannuation Act 1973*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

**2** After section 21 of the Principal Act the following section is inserted:—

Pension payable  
in case of  
member who  
died before  
appointed day.

“ 21A In the case of a member who has died before the appointed day a pension is payable under this Division as if he—

- (a) had died immediately after the appointed day; and
- (b) had ceased to be a member on the actual date of his death but had not retired voluntarily within the meaning of the repealed Act.”.
