ANALYSIS

- 1. Short title and citation.
- 2. Pension payable in case of member who died before appointed day.

AN ACT to amend the Parliamentary Superannuation Act 1973. [21 November 1974]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Parliamentary Superannua-Short title and tion Act 1974.
- (2) The Parliamentary Superannuation Act 1973, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 After section 21 of the Principal Act the following section is inserted:-

Pension payable in case of member who died before appointed day.

- "21A In the case of a member who has died before the appointed day a pension is payable under this Division as if he-
 - (a) had died immediately after the appointed day; and
 - (b) had ceased to be a member on the actual date of his death but had not retired voluntarily within the meaning of the repealed Act.".
