1. Short title, citation, and commencement.

AN ACT to amend the Parliamentary Superannuation Act 1973.

[30 September 1976]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Parliamentary Superannuation Act 1976*.

(2) The *Parliamentary Superannuation Act 1973*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3) The Principal Act shall be deemed always to have had effect as amended by this Act.

2 Section 25 of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by inserting the word “ or ” at the end of paragraph (a) of subsection (2);
- (b) by omitting paragraph (b) of that subsection; and
- (c) by omitting from that subsection the words “ or to hold that office or place of profit, as the case may be ”.
