## PUBLIC SERVICE (No. 2).

## No. 52 of 1970.

## AN ACT to amend the *Public Service Act* 1923. [15 December 1970.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Public Service Act* (No. 2) 1970.
- (2) The Public Service Act 1923, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Salaries of officers.

- 2 Section twenty-two of the Principal Act is amended—
  - (a) by omitting from subsection (3) the words "one month" and substituting therefor the words "ten working days";
  - (b) by omitting from subsection (4) the words "one month" and substituting therefor the words "ten working days"; and
  - (c) by adding at the end of the section the following subsection:—
    - "(6) In this section 'working day', in relation to an officer, means a day other than—
      - (a) a Saturday;
      - (b) a Sunday; or
      - (c) a day that-
        - (i) is a bank holiday or part bank holiday under the *Bank Holidays Act* 1919, either throughout the State or in the locality in which the officer is employed; or
        - (ii) is appointed, pursuant to subsection (3) of section sixty-six, as a holiday or half-holiday in the public offices of the State, either throughout the State or in the locality in which the officer is employed.".
