

## PUBLIC SERVICE (No. 2).

No. 52 of 1970.

AN ACT to amend the *Public Service Act 1923*.  
[15 December 1970.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title  
and citation.

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Public Service Act (No. 2) 1970*.

(2) The *Public Service Act 1923*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Salaries  
of officers.

**2** Section twenty-two of the Principal Act is amended—

(a) by omitting from subsection (3) the words “one month” and substituting therefor the words “ten working days”;

(b) by omitting from subsection (4) the words “one month” and substituting therefor the words “ten working days”; and

(c) by adding at the end of the section the following subsection:—

“(6) In this section ‘working day’, in relation to an officer, means a day other than—

(a) a Saturday;

(b) a Sunday; or

(c) a day that—

(i) is a bank holiday or part bank holiday under the *Bank Holidays Act 1919*, either throughout the State or in the locality in which the officer is employed; or

(ii) is appointed, pursuant to subsection (3) of section sixty-six, as a holiday or half-holiday in the public offices of the State, either throughout the State or in the locality in which the officer is employed.”.
