2. Amendment of section 16 of the *Parliamentary Superannuation Act 1973* (Members' superannuation pensions).



AN ACT to amend the Parliamentary Superannuation Act 1973 for the purpose of making further provision with respect to the entitlement of Members of Parliament to superannuation pensions.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Parliamentary Superannuation Amendment Act 1982*. Short title.

2—Section 16 (2) of the *Parliamentary Superannuation Act 1973** is amended by omitting paragraph (c) and substituting the following paragraph:—

- (c) that person's period of service as a member is 8 years or more but less than 15 years and he ceases to be a member by reason of his resignation—
- (i) after he has attained the age of 65 years; or
 - (ii) in any other circumstances that the Trust considers, and certifies in writing, to be sufficient.
