AN ACT to amend the *Parliamentary Superannuation Act 1973* to restore pension entitlements to widows and widowers of certain members

[Royal Assent 21 December 1989]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title

1—This Act may be cited as the *Parliamentary Superannuation Amendment Act 1989*.

Commencement

2—This Act shall commence on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Principal Act

3—In this Act, the *Parliamentary Superannuation Act 1973** is referred to as the Principal Act.

Amendment of section 23 of Principal Act (Rights of existing pensioners)

4—Section 23 of the Principal Act is amended by inserting the following subsection after subsection (2):—

(2A) Where a pension paid to the widow or widower of a former member ceased on remarriage before the appointed day that widow or widower shall be paid out of the Fund a pension calculated in accordance with the following provisions of this section as if that marriage had never taken place except that payment of the pension shall be suspended during the subsistence of the marriage.

Application

5—A pension that is payable under the Principal Act by virtue of the amendment made to that Act by this Act is not payable in respect of any period before this Act received the Royal Assent.
