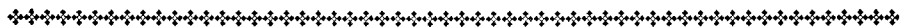

**AN ACT to amend the Parliamentary Salaries and Allowances Act 1973.**

[8 May 1975]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1—**(1) This Act may be cited as the *Parliamentary Salaries and Allowances Act 1975*. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Parliamentary Salaries and Allowances Act 1973*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Interpretation.

**2** Section 3 of the Principal Act is amended—

(a) by omitting the definition of “ ministerial office ” and substituting therefor the following definition:—

“ ‘ Minister ’ means a Minister of the Crown appointed as provided by the *Ministers of the Crown Act 1923*;”;

(b) by omitting from the end of the definition of “ Opposition Whip ” the words “ the holder of a ministerial office or a member of the Executive Council to whom paragraph 7 of the second schedule relates ” and substituting therefor the words “ a Minister ”; and

(c) by omitting subsection (4).

First schedule omitted.

**3** The Principal Act is amended by omitting the first schedule.

Second schedule amended.

**4** The second schedule to the Principal Act is amended—

(a) by omitting paragraphs 6 and 7 and substituting therefor the following paragraph:—

“ 6 In addition to the basic salary payable to him, there is payable to a person for the time being holding an office that is specified in the first column of the following table an additional salary comprising such percentage of the amount of the basic salary for the time being as is specified opposite to that office in the second column of that table, namely:—

First column Office	Second column Percentage of basic salary of which the additional salary is comprised.

Premier .....	125
Deputy Premier .....	85
Minister .....	70

”; and

(b) by omitting paragraph 8 (2) and substituting therefor the following paragraph:—

“(2) No salary is payable under this paragraph to a person who is the holder of the office of Leader for the Government in the Legislative Council at any time while that person is a Minister.”.

**5** The fourth schedule to the Principal Act is amended—Fourth schedule  
amended.

(a) by omitting from Part I the definition of “ relevant award ” and substituting therefor the following definition:—

“ ‘ relevant award ’ means a Conditions of Service Award made as provided by the *Public Service Act 1973* and in force at the relevant time.”;

(b) by omitting from the table in paragraph 6 the words “ ministerial office ” (twice occurring) and substituting therefor in each case the word “ Minister ”;

(c) by omitting from that table the words “ Member of Executive Council to whom paragraph 7 of the second schedule relates ” (twice occurring); and

(d) by omitting paragraph 8 (2) and substituting therefor the following sub-paragraph:—

“(2) This paragraph applies to a person who is the holder of the office of Premier, Deputy Premier, Minister, Leader for the Government in the Legislative Council, or Leader of the Opposition.”.
