AN ACT to amend the Parliamentary Salaries and Allowances Act 1973 for the purpose of making provision with respect to the salaries and allowances of the holder of the office of Secretary to Cabinet and for other purposes.

[Royal Assent 14 July 1982]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the Parliamentary Salaries and short title. Allowances Amendment Act 1982.

Commencement. **2**—(1) Except as provided in this section, this Act shall commence on the day on which this Act receives the royal assent.

(2) Section 4, in its application to any of the Schedules, shall commence on the day on which that Schedule commences or is deemed to have commenced, as the case may require.

(3) Schedule 1 shall be deemed to have commenced on 27th May 1982.

(4) Schedules 2 and 3 shall commence on 1st July 1982 or, if this Act has not then received the royal assent, shall be deemed to have commenced on that date.

Principal Act. **3**—In this Act, the Parliamentary Salaries and Allowances Act 1973* is referred to as the Principal Act.

Amendment of Principal Act.

4—The Principal Act is amended in the manner specified in column 2 of Schedules 1, 2, and 3 in relation to the relevant provision of that Act specified in column 1 of those Schedules.
