



PUBLIC SERVANTS' RETIRING AND DEATH ALLOWANCES AMENDMENT

TABLE OF PROVISIONS

1. Short title.
2. Amendment of section 3 of the *Public Servants' Retiring and Death Allowances Act 1925* (Retiring allowances to public servants).

AN ACT to amend the *Public Servants' Retiring and Death Allowances Act 1925* to make further provision in respect of the retirement or death of public servants of certain classes.

[Royal Assent 14 December 1979]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Public Servants' Retiring and Death Allowances Amendment Act 1979*. Short title.

2—Section 3 (1) of the *Public Servants' Retiring and Death Allowances Act 1925** is amended as follows:—

- (a) by omitting from paragraph (b) (iii) “unnecessary; or” and substituting “unnecessary;”;
- (b) by omitting from paragraph (c) “retires therefrom,” and substituting “retires; or”;
- (c) by inserting the following paragraph after paragraph (c):—
 - (d) being a police officer and having reached the age of 55 years, voluntarily retires,
