amounts

- (2) This section applies to every pension that is payable
 - (a) a person who, having been a contributor, retired before the first day of January 1961; or
 - (b) the widow of a person who, having been a contributor, retired or died before that date.
- (3) For the purposes of subsection (1) of this section, the prescribed sum is—
 - (a) in the case of a pension under Division I of Part V of the Principal Act, the sum of fifty-two pounds a year; and
 - (b) in the case of a pension under Division II of that Part, the sum of thirty-four pounds thirteen shillings and fourpence a year.
- 5 For the purposes of section twenty-six of the Principal **Co., to pay to the Fund Act-

(a) the Treasurer; and
(b) every State instrumentality or authority by which increased or by whom the salary of a person mentioned in rates of pension. subsection (2) of section four was payable immediately before his retirement or death (not being a salary that is payable from the Consolidated Revenue),

shall pay to the Superannuation Fund all such amounts as may be necessary to give effect to the alterations in the rates of pensions effected by this Act.

PUBLIC SERVICE SUPERANNUATION FUND.

No. 58 of 1964.

AN ACT to increase the rates of certain annuities payable under the Public Service Superannua-[26 November 1964.] tion Fund Act 1905.

RE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:--

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Public Service Super-short title, citation, and annuation Fund Act 1964.

commencement.

- (2) The Public Service Superannuation Fund Act 1905, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3) This Act shall commence on the twenty-sixth day of November 1964.

Increase in rates of certain annuities. No. 58.

- 2—(1) Subject to this Act, the rate of each annuity to which this section applies is, from and after the commencement of this Act, increased in accordance with the following provisions, namely:—
 - (a) In the case of an annuity payable to a subscriber, the rate thereof is increased by fifty-two pounds a year; and
 - (b) In the case of an annuity payable to the widow of a subscriber, the rate thereof is increased by thirty-four pounds thirteen shillings and fourpence a year.
- (2) This section applies to every annuity under the Principal Act that is payable to—
 - (a) a subscriber who retired before the first day of January 1961; or
 - (b) the widow of a subscriber who retired or died before that date.
- (3) Every annuity to which this section applies that is in force and payable on the twenty-fifth day of November 1964 shall, on and after the commencement of this Act, be paid at a rate increased in accordance with such of the provisions of subsection (1) of this section as may be appropriate.
- (4) The Treasurer shall pay to the Fund out of the Consolidated Revenue (which, to the necessary extent, is appropriated accordingly) all such amounts as may be necessary to give effect to the increases in the rates of annuities prescribed by this section.

Exclusion of certain annuities from the provisions of this Act. **3** Section two does not apply to any annuity that is payable to a person who is in receipt of a pension under Division I or Division II of Part V of the Superannuation Act 1938 (being a pension to which section four of the Superannuation Act 1964 applies).
