(2) The sum appropriated by subsection (1) of this section may be applied in the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June 1952 and in any subsequent financial years and may be applied partly in any one financial year and partly in any other financial year or financial years.

PUBLIC TRUST OFFICE.

No. 3 of 1952.

AN ACT to amend the Public Trust Office Act 1930. [22 April, 1952.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Public Trust Office Act 1952.
- (2) The Public Trust Office Act 1930, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Election to administer outste.

- 2 Section twenty of the Principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by omitting from subsection (1) the words "four hundred" and substituting therefor the words "seven hundred and fifty"; and
 - (b) by omitting from subsection (4) the words "six hundred" and substituting therefor the words "one thousand".

- 3—(1) Section forty of the Principal Act is amended—Investment of common fund.
 - (a) by inserting in subsection (1), after paragraph I., the following paragraph:—
 - "IA. In any securities the interest of which is for the time being guaranteed by the Parliament of the Commonwealth or of this State or of any other State of the Commonwealth:"; and
 - (b) by adding at the end of subsection (1) (in alignment with the beginning of that subsection) the words "and may also vary any such investment".
- (2) This section shall be deemed to have commenced on the first day of January, 1951.

SCOTTSDALE AND BRIDPORT SEPTIC TANKS.

AN ACT to amend the Scottsdale and Bridport Septic Tanks Act 1952. [22 April, 1952.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Scottsdale and Brid-short title port Septic Tanks Act 1952.
- (2) The Scottsdale and Bridport Septic Tanks Act 1951, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- 2 Section thirteen of the Principal Act is amended by Debentures omitting therefrom the words "not exceeding three pounds within ten and ten shillings per cent per annum" and substituting therefor the words "approved by the Auditor-General, but not exceeding, in any case, five pounds per cent per annum".
