AN ACT to amend the Public Trust Office Act 1930.

[31 August 1977]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Public Trust Office Act Short title, citation, and commencement.
- (2) The *Public Trust Office Act* 1930*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on 28th April 1977.

Power of Public Trustee to distribute estate when no claims received after advertisement for them.

- **2** Section 65 of the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end the following subsection:—
 - "(4) Nothing in this section—
 - (a) prejudices or affects the right of any person to follow an estate or any part of an estate into the hands of the person who has received it pursuant to a distribution under subsection (2); or
 - (b) prejudices the right of the Public Trustee to distribute an estate or any part of an estate under any other Act or other law or prejudices the protection afforded by that other Act or other law where he makes a distribution pursuant to it.".
