BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Public Works Construction Act 1941*.

2 The Principal Act is hereby amended by inserting after section eight thereof the following new section eight A—

“**8A**—(1) The Governor may make regulations for the purposes of this Act.

(2) Any such regulations may regulate and prescribe conditions in relation to the appointment, service, retirement, and leave of absence, of persons employed under or for the purposes of any Act relating to the carrying out of any public works.”
