PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE.

No. 2 of 1954.

AN ACT to amend the Public Works Committee Act 1914. [14 April, 1954.]

B^E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Public Works Committee Act* 1954.
- (2) The *Public Works Committee Act* 1914, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the **Principal Act**.

Functions of Committee. **2** Section fifteen of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (1) the word "ten" and substituting therefor the word "twenty-five".

Conditions precedent to commencing public works. 3 Section sixteen of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (1) the word "ten" and substituting therefor the word "twenty-five".

House of Assembly may extend Act to works to cost less than ten thousand pounds.

4 Section seventeen of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the word "ten" and substituting therefor the word "twenty-five".

WORKERS' COMPENSATION.

AN ACT to amend the Workers' Compensation Act 1953. [14 April, 1954.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title and commencement.

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Workers' Compensation Act 1954.
- (2) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the date of commencement of the Workers' Compensation Act 1953.
