

PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE.

No. 2 of 1954.

AN ACT to amend the *Public Works Committee Act* 1914. [14 April, 1954.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title
and citation.

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Public Works Committee Act* 1954.

(2) The *Public Works Committee Act* 1914, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Functions of
Committee.

2 Section fifteen of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (1) the word “ten” and substituting therefor the word “twenty-five”.

Conditions

3 Section sixteen of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (1) the word “ten” and substituting therefor the word “twenty-five”.

4 Section seventeen of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the word “ten” and substituting therefor the word “twenty-five”.

WORKERS' COMPENSATION.

AN ACT to amend the *Workers' Compensation Act* 1953. [14 April, 1954.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title
and com-
mencement.

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Workers' Compensation Act* 1954.

(2) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the date of commencement of the *Workers' Compensation Act* 1953.
