

Adaptation of amendments to reprint of Principal Act.

3—(1) On and after the date of the reprinting of the Principal Act—

- (a) this Act is to have effect as if from section two the symbols “ II ”, “ III ”, and “ IV ” (wherever occurring) were omitted and the symbols “ (b) ”, “ (c) ”, and “ (d) ”, respectively, were substituted therefor in each case; and
- (b) the Principal Act, as amended by this Act, shall be construed accordingly.

(2) The Principal Act and this Act are, by force of this subsection, amended to such extent as may be necessary to give effect to the foregoing provisions of this section.

(3) In this section, “ date of the reprinting of the Principal Act ” means the date of the giving of the certificate printed, pursuant to section six of the *Reprint of Statutes Act 1954*, in the volume of reprinted Acts published pursuant to that Act in which the reprint of the Principal Act is included.

PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE.

No. 66 of 1964.

AN ACT to amend the *Public Works Committee Act 1914*.
[17 December 1964.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title, citation, and commencement.

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Public Works Committee Act 1964*.

(2) The *Public Works Committee Act 1914*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3) Sections five and six of this Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the first day of October 1964.

Functions of Committee.

2 Section fifteen of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by omitting from subsection (1) thereof the words “ for which Parliamentary authority is

required" and substituting therefor the words "the cost of which is to be defrayed out of the Loan Fund"; and

- (b) by omitting from subsection (1) thereof the word "fifty" and substituting therefor the word "seventy".

3 Section sixteen of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by omitting from subsection (1) thereof the words "of any kind whatever" and substituting therefor the words "to which section fifteen applies" and by omitting from that subsection the word "fifty" and substituting therefor the word "seventy"; and

- (b) by adding at the end thereof the following subsection:—

"(5) If in a report under subsection (4) of this section, the Committee does not recommend the carrying out of the work to which the report relates, that work shall not be commenced unless and until it has been authorized by an Act."

Conditions precedent to commencing public works.

4 Section seventeen of the Principal Act is amended by omitting therefrom the word "fifty" and substituting therefor the word "seventy".

Power of House of Assembly to extend Act to works to cost less than £50,000.

5 Section thirty-two of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by omitting from subsection (2) thereof the words "and for each day while they are travelling to or from such a meeting,"; and

- (b) by adding at the end thereof the following subsection:—

"(3) In addition to the fees payable under or by virtue of the operation of any of the foregoing provisions of this section, the members of the Committee shall, until otherwise determined by the Tribunal referred to in subsection (1) of this section, be paid such allowances, fees, and emoluments, at such rates and subject to such conditions, as are for the time being prescribed in relation to members of Joint Select Committees by rules made pursuant to section six of the *Parliamentary Privilege Act 1898*."

Remuneration of members of the Committee.

6 Section thirty-four of the Principal Act is amended by inserting therein, after the word "conveyance", the words "by public transport by air or".
