Short title and citation.

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Public Works Committee Act 1967.
- (2) The *Public Works Committee Act* 1914, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

## LOCAL GOVERNMENT.

## No. 62 of 1967.

AN ACT to amend the Local Government Act 1962, the Hobart Corporation Act 1963, and the Launceston Corporation Act 1963.

[20 December 1967.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Local Government Act 1967.
- (2) The Local Government Act 1962, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

The Municipal Commission. 2 Section thirteen of the Principal Act is amended by inserting, at the end of subsection (8), the words "at which those minutes were confirmed".
