AN ACT to amend the Public Works Construction Act 1880. [1 May 1974]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Public Works Construction Short title and Act 1974.
- (2) The Public Works Construction Act 1880, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Regulations.

- 2 Section 8A of the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the following subsection:—
- "(3) Where regulations made under this section confer on the Minister any power or place upon him a duty in relation to any matter or class of matters the Minister may, by instrument in writing, delegate all or any of the powers and duties to the Director of Public Works, so that the delegated powers and duties may be exercised by the Director of Public Works with respect to the matter or class of matters specified in the instrument.".
