AN ACT to provide for the Execution of certain Public Works. [1 December, 1936.]

A.D. **1936** 

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the Public Works Execution short with. Act 1936.

#### A.D. 1936.

Power to Minister to cause works to be executed. 2 The Minister may cause the works specified in the first and second schedules to be undertaken and executed at a cost not exceeding in each case the amount set forth in those schedules in respect of each work, together with the cost of supervision thereof not exceeding the amount provided therefor in the second schedule.

Power to Treasurer to borrow £392,534. 3 The Treasurer may raise, borrow, and receive any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of three hundred and ninety-two thousand five hundred and thirty-four pounds, for the purpose of defraying the cost of the works authorised by this Act.

Application of certain unapplied balances.

4 If any part of the moneys provided by this Act is not required for the purposes of the work for which it was so provided, the Minister may expend the whole or any part of any such unexpended balance which does not exceed fifty pounds upon any other work which has been authorised by Parliament in respect of the same city or municipality as that in respect of which the amount was originally provided.
