AN ACT to provide for the Execution of certain Public Works. [13 November, 1941.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as

f 1 This Act may be cited as the Public Works Execution short title. Act 1941.

PUBLIC WORKS GENERALLY.

2 The Minister for Lands and Works may cause the works Power to specified in parts I. and II. of the first schedule to be under-Minister for taken and executed at a cost not exceeding in each case the Works to amount set forth in those parts of that schedule in respect specified in of each work, together with the cost of supervision thereof parts I and not exceeding the amount provided therefor in part II. of first that schedule be executed. that schedule.

3 The Treasurer, for the purpose of defraying the cost of the works authorised by section two, may —

Power to Treasurer to borrow £183,908 7s. 7d. and to reappropriate £5577 2s. 5d.

- I. Raise, borrow, and receive any sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of one hundred and eighty-three thousand nine hundred and eight pounds seven shillings and sevenpence: and
- II. Reappropriate the sums specified in part III. of the first schedule, amounting to five thousand five hundred and seventy-seven pounds two shillings and fivepence and apply the same for the purposes of this part.

Application of certain unapplied balances.

4 If any part of the moneys provided by this part is not required for the purpose of the work for which it was so provided, the Minister may expend the whole or any part of any such unexpended balance which does not exceed fifty pounds upon any other work which has been authorised by Parliament in respect of the same city or municipality in respect of which the amount was originally provided.

 - II. Reappropriate the sums specified in part III. of the second schedule, amounting to fifteen thousand three hundred and forty-three pounds ten shillings and sevenpence—

and apply the same, in accordance with the provisions of the *Transport Act* 1938, by way of capital expenditure in connection with the transport undertaking, as set out in the second schedule.
