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AN ACT to provide for the Execution of certain
Public Works. [13 November, 1941.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Public Works Execution Act* 1941. Short title.

PART I.

PUBLIC WORKS GENERALLY.

2 The Minister for Lands and Works may cause the works specified in parts I. and II. of the first schedule to be undertaken and executed at a cost not exceeding in each case the amount set forth in those parts of that schedule in respect of each work, together with the cost of supervision thereof not exceeding the amount provided therefor in part II. of that schedule.

- I. Raise, borrow, and receive any sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of one hundred and eighty-three thousand nine hundred and eight pounds seven shillings and sevenpence: and
- II. Reappropriate the sums specified in part III. of the first schedule, amounting to five thousand five hundred and seventy-seven pounds two shillings and fivepence and apply the same for the purposes of this part.

4 If any part of the moneys provided by this part is not required for the purpose of the work for which it was so provided, the Minister may expend the whole or any part of any such unexpended balance which does not exceed fifty pounds upon any other work which has been authorised by Parliament in respect of the same city or municipality in respect of which the amount was originally provided.

- I. Raise, borrow, and receive any sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of fifty-two thousand three hundred and six pounds nine shillings and fivepence: and
- II. Reappropriate the sums specified in part III. of the second schedule, amounting to fifteen thousand three hundred and forty-three pounds ten shillings and sevenpence—

and apply the same, in accordance with the provisions of the *Transport Act 1938*, by way of capital expenditure in connection with the transport undertaking, as set out in the second schedule.
