PUBLIC WORKS EXECUTION.

No. 5 of 1952.

AN ACT to provide for the execution and carrying out of certain Public Works and Purposes, and to authorise the borrowing of certain sums of money for meeting the cost of those Works and Purposes.

[22 April, 1952.]

B^E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title,

Works and purposes to be executed and carried out.

Power to Treasurer to borrow £181,600. **1** This Act may be cited as the Public Works Execution Act 1952.

2-(1) The public works and purposes specified in the schedule may be executed and carried out by the Minister administering the Act or Department under or for the purposes of which those works and purposes are respectively required to be executed or carried out.

(2) The cost of any public work or purposes specified in the first schedule shall not exceed the amount set forth therein in respect of each work or purpose.

3 The Treasurer may borrow any sums of money not exceeding $\pounds 181,600$, and may apply the same for the purpose of meeting the cost of the execution and carrying out of the public works and purposes specified in the schedule.
