AN ACT to provide for the Execution of certain Public Works. [13 December, 1937.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Public Works Execution (No. 2)

Power to Minister to sause works to b xecuted. 2 The Minister may cause the works specified in the schedule to be undertaken and executed at a cost not exceeding the amount set forth in the said schedule in respect thereof.

Pow r to Treasur r to borrow £4500. 3 It shall be lawful for the Treasurer to raise, borrow, and receive any sum of money not exceeding the sum of four thousand five hundred pounds for defraying the cost of the works authorised by this Act.
