## PUBLIC WORKS EXECUTION (No. 2).

---

No. 65 of 1948.

AN ACT to provide for the execution and carrying out of certain Public Works and Purposes, and to authorise the re-appropriation of money for meeting the cost of those Works and Purposes, and for the purposes of the *Transport Act 1938*.  
[15 December, 1948.]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title.

**1** This Act may be cited as the *Public Works Execution Act (No. 2) 1948*.

### PART I.

#### PUBLIC WORKS AND PURPOSES GENERALLY.

Works and purposes to be executed and carried out.

**2**—(1) The public works and purposes specified in the first schedule may be executed and carried out by the Minister administering the Act or Department under or for the purposes of which those works and purposes are respectively required to be executed or carried out.

(2) The cost of any public work or purpose specified in the first schedule shall not exceed the amount set forth therein in respect of each work or purpose.

**3** The Treasurer may, out of the moneys available to him under section five of this Act, apply such sums of money, not exceeding £410,186, as may be necessary for the purpose of meeting the cost of the execution and carrying out of the public works and public purposes specified in the first schedule.

## PART II.

### TRANSPORT UNDERTAKING.

**4** The Treasurer may, out of the moneys available to him under section five of this Act, apply any sums, not exceeding £225,500, in accordance with the provisions of the *Transport Act 1938\**, by way of capital expenditure in connection with the transport undertaking, as set forth in the second schedule.

## PART III.

### FINANCIAL PROVISIONS.

**5** The Treasurer may re-appropriate the amounts specified in the third schedule, amounting to £635,686, and may apply the same for the purpose of meeting the cost of the execution and carrying out of the public works and public purposes specified in the first and second schedules.

Power of Treasurer to re-appropriate £635,686.
