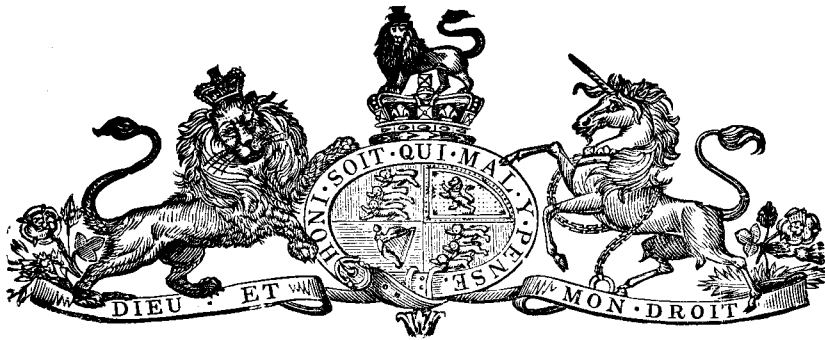

AN ACT to authorise the Council of the Municipality of Queenstown to apply Surplus Moneys standing to the credit of the Lighting Account of the Council for other Municipal Purposes. [3 September, 1935.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Queenstown Lighting Account* Short title. (*Surplus Moneys Appropriation*) Act 1935.

2 Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, it shall be lawful for the Council of the Municipality of Queenstown, at any time or times in any financial year, to appropriate and apply, out of the moneys for the time being standing to the credit of the Lighting Account of the Council, any such sum or sums of money as the Council shall by resolution determine, not exceeding in the whole the amount which was standing to the credit of such Lighting Account at the end of the previous financial year, in or towards defraying the cost of the carrying out or doing of any purpose or work which the Council shall by such resolution determine, and which it is by law authorised to so carry out or do.

Proviso.

Provided, however, that the Council shall, when making any such appropriation and application as aforesaid, have due regard to the total amount of the accounts and liabilities, if any, of the Council which were outstanding in respect of such Lighting Account at the end of such previous financial year.
