# AN ACT to amend the Railway Advances and 1944 Suspense Accounts Act 1923. [17 November, 1944.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Railway Advances short title and Suspense Accounts Act 1944.
- (2) The Railway Advances and Suspense Accounts Act 1923\*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
