AN ACT to amend the *Railway Advances and Suspense Accounts Act 1923*. A.D. 1944  
[17 November, 1944.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania,  
 by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative  
 Council and House of Assembly, as follows:—

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Railway Advances and Suspense Accounts Act 1944*. Short title  
and citation.

(2) The *Railway Advances and Suspense Accounts Act 1923*\*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
