

Control and management of certain wharves vested in the Marine Board of Flinders.

3 On the commencement of this Act, the control and management of all wharves that are—

(a) available for use by the public; and

(b) within the jurisdiction of the Marine Board of Flinders,

shall, by force of this section and without further authority, cease to be vested in any other person or authority and shall become vested in the Board.

RACING AND GAMING.

No. 18 of 1953.

AN ACT to amend the *Racing and Gaming Act 1952*.
[20 April, 1953.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Racing and Gaming Act 1953*.

(2) The *Racing and Gaming Act 1952* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Appointment, &c., of officers of clubs.

2 Section forty-one of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (5) the word “so”.

Appeals from decisions of stewards, &c.

3 Section forty-two of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (4) the words “and place” and substituting therefor the word “fixed”.

Special totalizer licences.

4 Section forty-eight of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after sub-paragraph (ii) of paragraph (a) of subsection (1) the word “or”.

Refusal of application for registration.

5 Section sixty-one of the Principal Act is amended—

(a) by omitting subsection (3); and

(b) by re-numbering subsection (4) as subsection (3).

6 Section sixty-six of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from paragraph (b) of subsection (14) the numerals "1953" and substituting therefor the numerals "1954". Betting premises.

7 Section sixty-nine of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (3) the word "a" (first occurring) and substituting therefor the word "the". Duties of bookmakers.

8 Section one hundred and seven of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after paragraph (d) of subsection (2) the word "and". Power to enter and search places used for, and arrest persons suspected of, offences against this Act.

9 The first schedule to the Principal Act is amended—

(a) by omitting the item "4 Geo. VI. No. 29 | *Gaming Act 1940*"; Acts repealed.

(b) by inserting after the item "4 & 5 Geo. VI. No. 87 | *Bookmakers Act 1941*" the following item:—

"6 Geo. VI. No. 42 | *Gaming Act 1942*.";

(c) by omitting the item "11 & 12 Geo. VI. No. 81 | *Gaming Act 1947*"; and

(d) by adding at the end thereof the following item:—
"No. 85 of 1951 | *Bookmakers Act (No. 2) 1951*."

CECILIA BUTTON MEMORIAL HOSPITAL AGREEMENT.

No. 19 of 1953.

AN ACT to amend the *Cecilia Button Memorial Hospital Agreement Act 1946*. [20 April, 1953.]

WHEREAS by his will dated the seventh day of February 1933 (in this Act referred to as "the will") *Henry Edwin Button* directed his trustees to found for the benefit of the people of the municipality of Oatlands a hospital to be known as "The Cecilia Button Memorial Hospital" and to apply certain moneys in or towards the erection and equipment of a suitable hospital and in the maintenance of that hospital, and set forth certain provisions and conditions relating to the establishment and maintenance of that hospital: Preamble.
