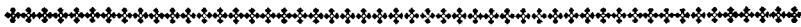

AN ACT to amend the *Roads and Jetties Act* <sup>A.D.</sup> 1941.  
1935. [17 June, 1941.]

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1** This Act may be cited as the *Roads and Jetties Act* 1941. Short title.

**2** The Principal Act is hereby amended—

I. By deleting the words “or under any previous Act” in sections fifty-four B and fifty-four C thereof respectively:

New section  
54D.

II. By inserting after the said section fifty-four C the following new section fifty-four D—

Power to  
lease unused  
jetties.

“**54D**—In relation to any jetty the control and management of which is vested in it under this Part, the Transport Commission or the council of a municipality, as the case may be, may grant a lease of such jetty to any person upon and subject to such terms and conditions as it may think fit if, in the opinion of such controlling body, such jetty is not required for public use.”: and

Section 55.

III. By inserting in section fifty-five thereof after “such jetty” in subsection (2) the words “and generally regulating such use”.
