

RETIREMENT BENEFITS AMENDMENT ACT 1981

AN ACT to amend the Retirement Benefits Act 1970 for the purpose of making further provision with respect to the payment of benefits to certain male contributors to the Retirement Benefits Fund who retire on attaining the age of 63 years.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the Retirement Benefits Amendment short title. Act 1981.

Principal Act.

2—In this Act, the Retirement Benefits Act 1970* is referred to as the Principal Act.

Amendment of section 26 of Principal Act (Rights of contributors for full benefits).

3—Section 26 (4) of the Principal Act is amended by omitting "1981" and substituting "1982".

Amendment of section 27 of Principal Act (Rights of contributors for limited benefits). 4—Section 27 (5A) (a) of the Principal Act is amended by omitting "1981" and substituting "1982".
