

- (b) the remuneration and the other terms and conditions of employment of officers of the advanced education service;
- (c) the proceedings of the Council and the advisory bodies;
- (d) the qualifications to be held by persons (whether obtained in this State or elsewhere) before they are entitled to undertake any prescribed course of advanced education provided under this Act or enter any prescribed examination conducted by, or on behalf of, the Council;
- (e) the fees that may be charged under this Act;
- (f) the granting under this Act of diplomas, certificates, and other awards;
- (g) the granting under this Act of scholarships, exhibitions, bursaries, and prizes; and
- (h) the disposal and other dealings with property vested in the Council.

(2) Regulations under this Act may impose penalties, not exceeding in any case fifty dollars, in respect of the contravention of any provision thereof.

**20** The powers of the Governor to appoint officers for the purposes of the *Education Act 1932* shall be deemed to include, and shall be deemed always to have included, power to appoint, before the commencement of this Act, a person to be the Registrar, and any person so appointed who, immediately before the commencement of this Act, holds office as Registrar shall, on that commencement, be deemed to have been appointed Registrar under this Act.

## RURAL FIRES (CONFIRMATION).

---

No. 11 of 1968.

AN ACT to confirm the *Rural Fires Act 1967*.

[5 July 1968.]

**W**HEREAS a Bill for an Act to amend the law relating to the prevention and control of rural fires, to make provision with respect to matters incidental thereto, and to repeal certain enactments, having passed both Houses of Parliament, was on the twentieth day of December 1967 presented to the Governor for Her Majesty's Assent without the customary or any other enacting words and was so assented to in Her Majesty's name on that day and was numbered Act No. 75 of 1967 and dealt with as required by the *Acts Custody Act 1858* and published accordingly:

Preamble.

And whereas the copy of the said Act No. 75 of 1967 deposited in the Supreme Court under the *Acts Custody Act 1858* was with the customary enacting words written therein presented again to the Governor and the alteration was initialled by him:

And whereas it is expedient to confirm the said Act No. 75 of 1967 as from the twentieth day of December 1967 and the said alteration made and initialled by the Governor therein:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Citation.

**1** This Act may be cited as the *Rural Fires (Confirmation) Act 1968*.

Confirmation of Act.

**2** It is declared that—

(a) the said Act No. 75 of 1967 is a good and valid Act as from the twentieth day of December 1967 which was the day on which the Governor assented to it in Her Majesty's name; and

(b) it was lawful and proper to give effect by the said alteration to the purpose and intent of the Governor and both Houses of Parliament.

**3** Every copy of the said Act No. 75 of 1967 printed by the Government Printer without any enacting words shall be deemed to contain the said alteration.

AN ACT to authorize the Treasurer to guarantee the repayment of a loan proposed to be made to Cleveland Tin N.L. by the National Bank of Australasia Limited and the payment of the interest payable in respect of that loan, and to provide for matters incidental thereto.
