AN ACT to amend the Rural Fires Act 1967 to increase the membership of the Rural Fires Board.

[11 December 1975]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Rural Fires Act 1975.

Short title and

(2) The Rural Fires Act 1967, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Constitution of the Board.

- 2 Section 7 of the Principal Act is amended—
- (a) by omitting from subsection (2) the word "sixteen" and substituting the numeral "17"; and
- (b) by inserting in subsection (3), after paragraph (d), the following paragraph:—
 - "(da) one shall be the Director of the State Emergency Service or his nominee;".
