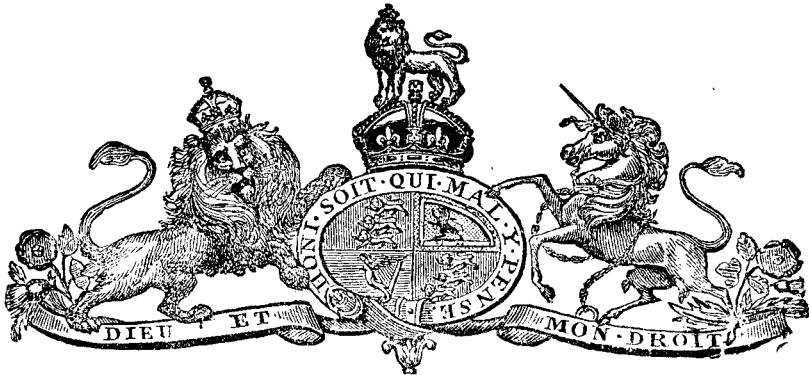

2. Power for Minister to purchase machinery and undertake works.

AN ACT to provide for the Purchase of certain Machinery and Articles, and for the Execution of certain Works, in connection with the State Railways. [19 August, 1935.]

Enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Railway Machinery Purchase and Works Execution Act 1935*. Short title.

2 The Minister may cause to be purchased the machinery and articles, and to be executed and undertaken the works, specified in the first and second schedules, at a cost not exceeding in each case the amount specified in the appropriate schedule in respect thereof. Power for Minister to purchase machinery and undertake works

3 It shall be lawful for the Treasurer to raise, borrow, and receive, for the purposes of this Act, any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum of thirty-two thousand and six hundred and forty pounds.
