E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the Railway Machinery Purchase Short title. and Works Execution Act 1935.

2 The Minister may cause to be purchased the machinery Power for and articles, and to be executed and undertaken the works, Minister to specified in the first and second schedules, at a cost not exceed- purchase ing in each case the amount specified in the appropriate machinery and undertake schedule in respect thereof.
