AN ACT to amend the *Reprint of Statutes Act* 1954. [5 August 1964.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Reprint of Statutes Short title Act 1964.
- (2) The Reprint of Statutes Act 1954, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- 2 Section six of the Principal Act is amended by inserting Certificate in subsection (1) thereof, before the words "the form", the General to be words "or to the effect of".

NOXIOUS WEEDS.

No. 3 of 1964.

AN ACT to repeal the *Noxious Weeds Act* 1938, and to make fresh provision to secure the eradication or control of certain weeds.

[5 August 1964.]

B^E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title and commencement.

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Noxious Weeds Act 1964.
- (2) This Act shall commence on a date to be fixed by proclamation.

Repeal. 2 The Noxious Weeds Act 1938 is repealed.
