### AN ACT to amend the Radiographers Registration Act 1971.

[14 October 1974]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Radiographers Registration Act 1974*. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Radiographers Registration Act 1971*, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

**2** Section 3 (2) (c) of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after the word “the” (second occurring) the words “Tasmanian Branch of the”.

**3** Section 4 (5) (e) of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the word “is” and substituting therefor the word “it”.

**4** Section 9 (6) of the Principal Act is amended—

(a) by omitting the words “thirty-first day of January” and substituting therefor the numeral and word “28th February”; and

(b) by omitting the words “thirty-first day of December” and substituting therefor the numeral and word “31st January”.

**5** The Principal Act is amended by inserting, after section 10, the following section:—

Provisional  
registration.

“10A—(1) Subject to subsection (2), a member of the Board may grant provisional registration to any person who, in the opinion of the member, would be entitled to be granted registration on his application in that behalf being made to the Board.

“(2) Provisional registration under subsection (1) shall not be granted unless the member granting it is satisfied that the person to whom it is granted is of good fame and character.

“(3) On granting provisional registration under this section, the member of the Board doing so shall forthwith give notice thereof to the secretary of the Board.

“(4) A provisional registration under this section is effective as registration under this Act for the purpose of section 14 and continues effective—

(a) until an application by the person so provisionally registered to be registered under this Act is accepted or rejected by the Board; or

(b) the expiration of the period of 6 months from the date of the grant of the provisional registration, whichever is the sooner.”.
