AN ACT to approve an agreement for the continuation of financial assistance by the Commonwealth to rural industries.

[30 November 1976]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Rural Reconstruction Act* Short title and citation. 1976.

(2) The *Rural Reconstruction Act* 1971, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Approval of agreement for the continuation of financial assistance to rural industries.

2 An agreement by the Premier with the Prime Minister for the extension to 31st December 1976 of the date to which the Commonwealth will make available financial assistance to the State for the purposes of the Scheme under section 4 of the Principal Act is approved.

The Scheme.

3 Section 4 of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after the word " authorized " the words " or approved ".

Negotiations for the continuation of the Scheme.

4 The Premier is hereby authorized—

- (a) to negotiate with the Commonwealth for the extension to 30th June 1977 of the date to which the Commonwealth will make available financial assistance to the State for the purpose of the Scheme under section 4 of the Principal Act; and
- (b) if the Commonwealth agrees to the extension of that date, to enter into an agreement giving effect to that agreement.
