AN ACT to apply out of the Consolidated Revenue 1941. a Sum for the Service of the year ending the Thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred [3 June, 1941.] and forty-two.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :---

**1** This Act may be cited as the Supply Act 1941-42.

2 There shall and may be issued and applied towards mak-Issue and ing good the supply hereby granted to His Majesty for the application service of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-two, the sum of five hundred and fifty-six thousand four hundred and seventy pounds out of the Consolidated Revenue, for the purposes and services expressed in the schedule to this Act; and the Treasurer is hereby authorised and empowered to issue and apply the moneys authorised to be issued and applied.

**Credit** to be given to the **Treasurer** in accounts. **3** The said sum shall be available to satisfy the warrants under the hand of the Governor in respect of any purposes and services set forth in the said schedule.

**4** The Treasurer shall be allowed credit in his accounts for any sums of money paid by him in pursuance of any such warrant as aforesaid; and the receipts of the respective persons to whom the same are so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the Treasurer in passing his said accounts for any such sums as are therein mentioned, and he shall receive credit for the same accordingly.
