

## SESQUICENTENARY.

### No. 63 of 1950.

AN ACT to amend the *Sesquicentenary Act 1949*.  
[7 December, 1950.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Sesquicentenary Act* Short title and citation.

(2) The *Sesquicentenary Act 1949\**, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

**2** Section three of the Principal Act is amended by Sesqui-centennial Committee. omitting from paragraph (e) of subsection (2) the words “not exceeding five”.

## PRICES (No. 3).

### No. 64 of 1950.

AN ACT to amend the *Prices Act 1948*.  
[7 December, 1950.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Prices Act (No. 3)* Short title and citation.  
1950.

(2) The *Prices Act 1948\**, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the twenty-ninth day of November, 1950.

**2** Section forty-eight of the Principal Act is repealed and Expiry of Act. the following section is substituted therefor:—

“48. This Act shall expire on the thirtieth day of June, 1951.”
